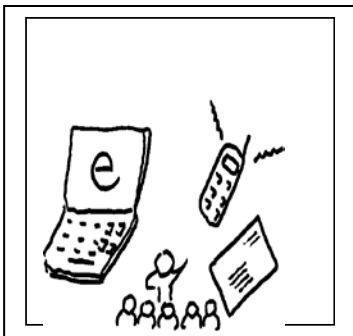


Introduction

This is called a consultation.

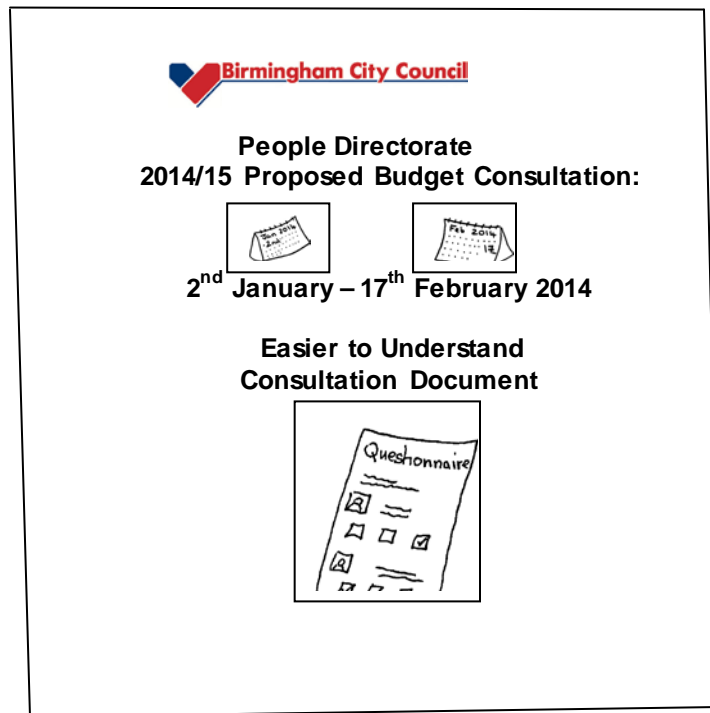
