School Organisation Proposal: removal of boarding provision from Baskerville School

Dear Parents, Carers, Staff and other stakeholders,

I am writing to inform you that Baskerville Governing Body with the support of Birmingham City Council (the Council) is publishing the following statutory proposal to:

- Remove boarding provision

Baskerville School (a community special school) currently offers 183 places to pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

There are currently no pupils on roll at the school that have boarding listed within their EHCP and there have been no such pupils on roll for many years. The proposed change will mean that the residential buildings on the school site can be repurposed to support the school in the education improvement journey.

The statutory consultation for this proposal will last four-weeks from 20th June 2024 to 18th July 2024, this is known as the “representation period”.

The Council invites all interested people to comment on the proposal during this representation period.
