

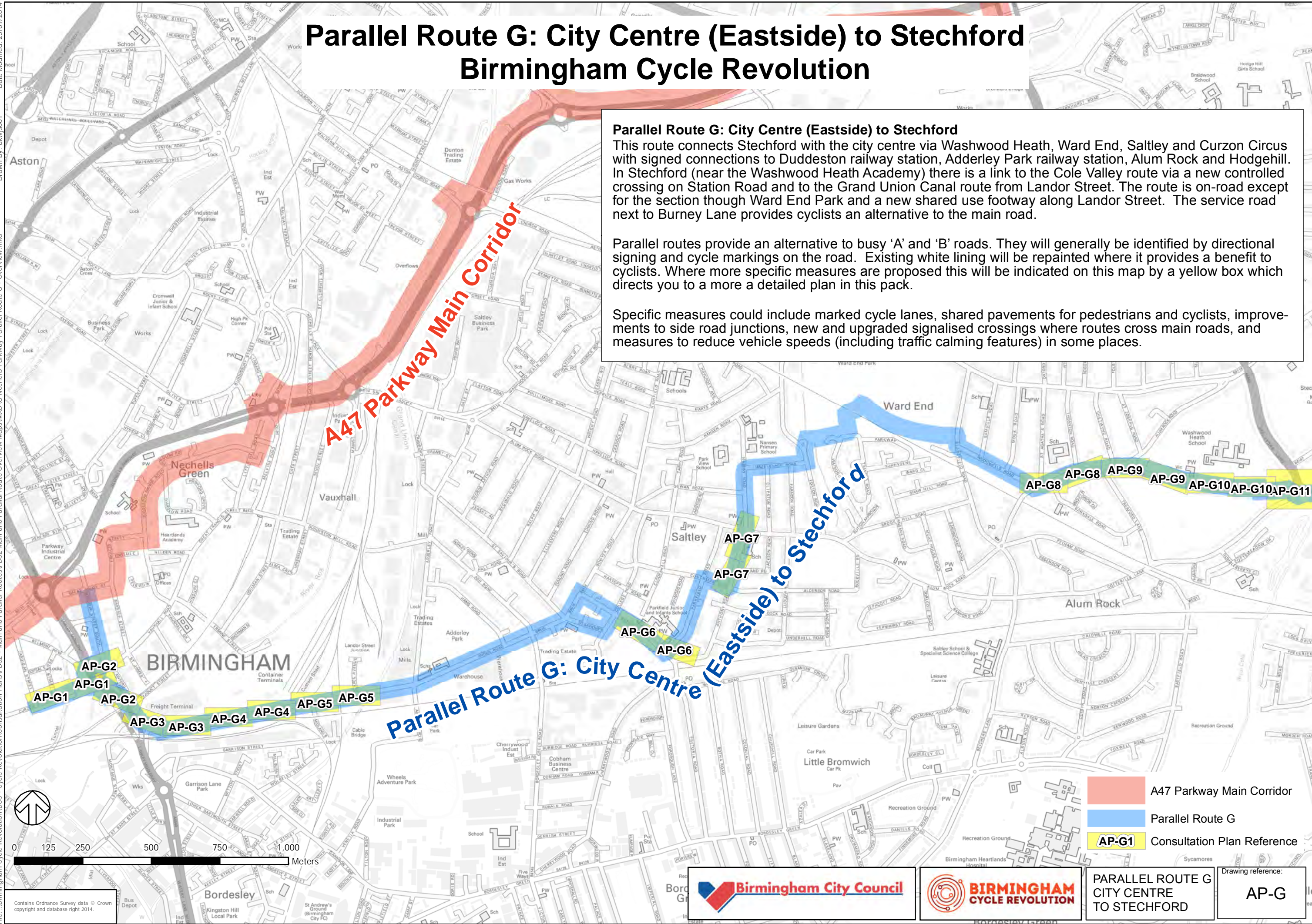
Parallel Route G: City Centre (Eastside) to Stechford Birmingham Cycle Revolution

Parallel Route G: City Centre (Eastside) to Stechford

This route connects Stechford with the city centre via Washwood Heath, Ward End, Salfley and Curzon Circus with signed connections to Duddeston railway station, Adderley Park railway station, Alum Rock and Hodgehill. In Stechford (near the Washwood Heath Academy) there is a link to the Cole Valley route via a new controlled crossing on Station Road and to the Grand Union Canal route from Landor Street. The route is on-road except for the section through Ward End Park and a new shared use footway along Landor Street. The service road next to Burney Lane provides cyclists an alternative to the main road.

Parallel routes provide an alternative to busy 'A' and 'B' roads. They will generally be identified by directional signing and cycle markings on the road. Existing white lining will be repainted where it provides a benefit to cyclists. Where more specific measures are proposed this will be indicated on this map by a yellow box which directs you to a more a detailed plan in this pack.

Specific measures could include marked cycle lanes, shared pavements for pedestrians and cyclists, improvements to side road junctions, new and upgraded signalised crossings where routes cross main roads, and measures to reduce vehicle speeds (including traffic calming features) in some places.
