I am writing to advise you that on 29th August 2025 Birmingham City Council, as the Local Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred on it, has determined to implement the proposal at Bellfield Junior School, as detailed:

- Establish Special Educational Needs (SEN) Provision in a mainstream school by providing a SEN Resource Base at Bellfield Junior School for up to 12 pupils with Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD).
- With effect from 1st January 2026.
