School Organisation Proposal: Establish a Resource Base

Dear Parents, Carers, Staff, Governors and other stakeholders,

I am writing to inform you that Birmingham City Council is publishing the following proposal, in close collaboration with the leadership and governing body of Bellfield Junior School:

- Establish SEN provision by creating a SEN “Resource Base” for up to 12 pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) for Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
- Implementation date 1st January 2026
