Dear Sir / Madam,

Clapgate Lane / Stonehouse Lane - Safety Scheme

Birmingham City Council has an obligation to undertake safety schemes on the Highway. In order to undertake this commitment funding has been secured to enable a programme of schemes to be delivered. Schemes are selected using criteria set out in the current Birmingham Road Safety Strategy. We are writing to you to advise you that Clapgate Lane / Stonehouse Lane_between Kettles Wood Drive and Woodgate Valley Fire Station, has been identified within the Safety Scheme Programme, as meeting the criteria and the following interventions have been identified.

We are therefore proposing to make the following improvements on Stoney Lane to improve road safety:

- New traffic calming road markings west of Sommerfield Lane and east of the service road off Stonehouse Lane.
- New uncontrolled drop crossing facility and associated tactile paving on Clapgate Lane near the junction of Parkside plus upgraded advance school ahead warning sign.
- Jiggins Lane new Advance directional signage for the junction of Clapgate Lane / Stonehouse Lane/ Jiggins Lane. Sign to advise of correct lane use, additional lane arrows.
- Upgraded pedestrian crossing sign on Stonehouse Lane

Before we move to the next stage of preparing to bid for funding we would welcome any comments or questions that you have on this proposal. It is important that residents in the vicinity of the proposed works know what is happening and are able to comment on it. Please use the following link
