School Organisation Proposal: Amalgamate two schools (by discontinuance and enlargement).

Dear Parents, Carers, Staff and other stakeholders,

I am writing to inform you of proposals that Birmingham City Council is developing in close collaboration with the leadership and governing bodies of Beeches Infant School and Beeches Junior School (the Schools):

- Discontinue Beeches Infant School;
- Enlarge Beeches Junior School
- Alter the age range of Beeches Junior School to 4 – 11 year olds
- Implementation 1st September 2026

Beeches Junior School (a Community School) currently offers 360 places and rated 'Good' by Ofsted in June 2023. Beeches Infant School (a Community School) currently offers 270 places and rated 'Good' by Ofsted in December 2022.

The informal consultation period ("pre-publication period") will run from 9 June 2025 to 11 July 2025. The council invites all interested people to comment on the proposal during this period. A proposal document and online survey are available via this link:
