NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make these Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 101 and 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be as follows:

1. To introduce Prohibition of Right Turn restrictions on lengths of DARTMOUTH MIDDLEWAY.
2. To introduce Prohibition of U-Turn restrictions on lengths of DARTMOUTH MIDDLEWAY.
3. To introduce Mandatory Left Turn restrictions of lengths of LISTER STREET and GREAT LISTER STREET.
4. To introduce a Bus Only Restriction on a length of DARTMOUTH MIDDLEWAY.

**DARTMOUTH MIDDLEWAY & LISTER STREET, NECHELLS
ESTABLISHMENT OF SHARED USE FOOTWAY AND CYCLEWAY**

NOTICE is also hereby given that the above named council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 65 (1), 65 (2) and 66 of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers hereby propose to introduce a section of shared use footway and cycleway at the following approximate locations:

1. DARTMOUTH MIDDLEWAY and LISTER STREET

**DARTMOUTH MIDDLEWAY & LISTER STREET, NECHELLS
ESTABLISHMENT OF PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS**

NOTICE is also hereby given that the above named Council intends under Sections 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), to establish Toucan Crossings at the following approximate locations:

1. DARTMOUTH MIDDLEWAY and LISTER STREET
