School Organisation Proposal: Remove Boarding Provision

Dear Parents, Carers, Staff and other stakeholders,

I am writing to inform you of proposals that Birmingham City Council is developing in close collaboration with the leadership and governing body of Lindsworth School:

- Remove Boarding Provision
- Implementation 1st April 2027

Lindsworth School currently offers 160 places to pupils aged 9 to 16 years old with Social Emotional and Mental Health Needs (SEMH). At the last Ofsted inspection in December 2024 the school was rated 'Good'. Lindsworth School has not admitted pupils with an EHCP for a boarding place for several years and there are currently no pupils on roll at the school that require boarding provision as part of their EHCP.

The informal consultation period 'Pre-Publication period' will run from **9th March 2026** to **27th March 2026**. The council invites all interested stakeholders to comment on the proposal during this period. A proposal document and online survey are available via this link:

All comments received at this stage will be reviewed by the Council and the School prior to proceeding to the formal statutory process.

I will write to you again at the launch of the formal statutory process (known as the 'Representation Period') which is the required formal 4-week consultation process. This will be a further opportunity for stakeholders to read the proposal document, that may be updated following the outcome of the informal 'Pre – Publication stage' and submit written comments at that time. All comments received at the formal stage will be submitted to the decision maker to enable them to make a decision.
