
CITY OF BIRMINGHAM

THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (NO. 1) ORDER, 1970.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY BOROUGH OF BIRMINGHAM in exercise of their powers under section 74(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the City of Birmingham and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order as follows:-

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. This Order may be cited as The City of Birmingham (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 1) Order, 1970, and shall come into operation on the Seventeenth day of August One thousand nine hundred and seventy.
