The West Midlands County Council (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit)(No. 8) Order 1982

The County Council of West Midlands in exercise of their powers under Section 74(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Section 186 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967 and with the consent of the Minister of Transport given under the Section 84B of the Act of 1967 hereby order as follows:-

- No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. This Order may be cited as The West Midlands County Council (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit)(No. 8) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 8th day of October 1982

SCHEDULE

That length of Redditch Road (A441) in the County of West Midlands which extends from a point 76 metres north-east of its junction with Burford Park Road southwest-wards to a point 22 metres south-west of its junction with Redhill Lane a distance of approximatley 1160 metres measured along the said length of road.
