(40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1983

The County Council of West Midlands in exercise of their powers under Section 74(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967 and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport given under Section 84B of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The West Midlands County Council (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1983" and shall come into operation on the 8th day of August, 1983.

SCHEDULE

That length of the A45 known as Coventry Road and New Coventry Road in the County of West Midlands which extends from a point 14 metres east of its junction with Howard Road to a point 56 metres east of its junction with Arden Oak Road, a distance of approximately 3,970 metres measured along the said length of road.
