The County Council of West Midlands ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport given under Part II of Schedule 9 to the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. The West Midlands County Council (40 mph Speed Limit) (No 7) Order 1982 is hereby revoked in its entirety
- 3. This Order may be cited as "The County Council of West Midlands (40 mph Speed Limit) (No 1) Order 1986" and shall come into operation on the 29th day of March 1986.

SCHEDULE

ISLINGTON ROW MIDDLEWAY - from a point approximately 31 metres east of the roundabout junction at Hagley Road to its junction with Lee Bank Middleway

LEE BANK MIDDLEWAY - from its junction with Islington Row Middleway to its junction with Belgrave Middleway

UNNAMED UNDERPASS - from its junction with Lee Bank Middleway to its junction with Belgrave Middleway

BELGRAVE MIDDLEWAY - from its junction with Lee Bank Middleway to the roundabout junction with Pershore Road

BELGRAVE MIDDLEWAY - from the roundabout junction at Pershore Road to the roundabout junction with Highgate Middleway

HIGHGATE MIDDLEWAY - for its full length

CAMP HILL MIDDLEWAY

North east bound carriageway - from its junction with Highgate Middleway to a point 30 metres north east of the line of the kerb on the north east side of Stratford Place

South west bound carriageway - from a point 52 metres north east of the line of the kerb on the north east side of John Kempe Way to its junction with Highgate Middleway
