ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967 THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (NO. 3) ORDER, 1978

The District Council of the City of Birmingham pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of West Midlands, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 72(3) 73(1) and 74(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967 and with the consent of the Secretary of State for the Environment given under section 84B of the Act of 1967, in so far as such consent is required, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

- 1. The length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 71 of the Act of 1967.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. This Order may be cited as the City of Birmingham District Council (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 7th day of August 1978.

Schedule 1

That length of road known as the Wolverhapton Road South (A4123) which extends from its junction with Ridgacre Road, northwards to its junction with Hagley Road West, a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 620 yards.

Schedule 2

That length of road known as the Wolverhampton Road South (A4123) which extends from its junction with Ridgacre Road, northwards to its junction with Hagley Road West, a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 620 yards.
