BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (A38 SUTTON COLDFIELD BY-PASS, SUTTON WALMLEY & MINWORTH) (SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018

Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on the 12th day of October Two thousand and eighteen and may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (A38 Sutton Coldfield By-pass, Sutton Walmley & Minworth) (Speed Limit) Order 2018".
- 4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 ("the Regulations") when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of the Regulations.
- 5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the Interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULE 1

A38 Sutton Coldfield By-pass (north-east carriageway) from a point approximately 40 metres north of the extended northern kerb line of the gyratory at its junction with Kingsbury (Minworth Island) in a generally north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 370 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

A38 Sutton Coldfield By-pass (north-east carriageway) from the northern kerb line of the gyratory at its junction with Kingsbury Road (Minworth Island) in a generally north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 40 metres.

A38 Sutton Coldfield By-pass (south-west carriageway) from the northern kerb line of the gyratory at its junction with Kingsbury Road (Minworth Island) in a generally north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 40 metres.
