
The Council of the Borough of Sutton Coldfield (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order, 1936,

The Council of the Borough of Sutton Coldrield in exercise of their powers under section 11(1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Warwick and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order as follows:-

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on either of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. This Order may be cited as "The Council of the Borough of Sutton Coldfield (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit)(No. 2) Order 1966".

- 1. That length of Springfield Road which extends from its junction with Lindridge Road to its junction with Walmley Road, a distance of approximately 2,430 yards.
- 2. That length of Lindridge Road which extends from its junction with Springfield Road to its junction with Rectory Road, a distance of approximately 935 yards.
