

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1962

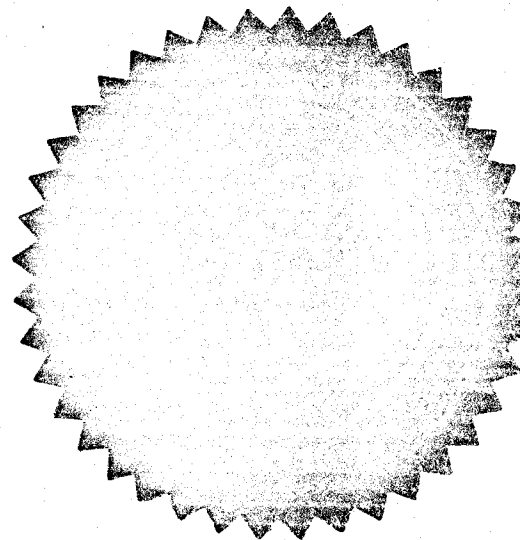
The Borough Council of Sutton Coldfield
(40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order, 1966

The Council of the Borough of Sutton Coldfield in exercise of their powers under section 11(1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Warwick and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order as follows:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order may be cited as the Borough Council of Sutton Coldfield (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order, 1966.
