ORDER 1973 (VARIATION) ORDER 2004


Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th day of September Two thousand and four and may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (The Borough of Sutton Coldfield) (40 miles per hour Speed Limit and Restricted Roads) (No.10) Order 1973 (Variation) Order 2004"
2. The reference to Wylde Green Road contained in Schedule One to The Borough of Sutton Coldfield (40 miles per hour Speed Limit and Restricted Roads) (No. 10) Order 1973 (as amended) is hereby deleted.
3. The length of Wylde Green Road referred to in Article 2 of this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act of 1984.
4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
