ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1934.

THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM (BUILT UP AREAS) ORDER,
(No. 2). 1950.

The City and County Borough Council of Birmingham in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (4) of Section I of the Road Traffic Act, 1934, and having consulted with the Chief Officer of Police for the City of Birmingham HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT as follows:-

1. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be deemed not to be a road in a built up area for the purposes of the said Section I.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order may be cited as "The City of Birmingham (Built Up Areas) Order (No. 2) 1950".

SCHEDULE

CHESTER ROAD (Route A.452) from its junction with Kingsbury Road to its junction with Orphanage Road (a distance of approximately 2397 yards).
