The West Midlands County Council
(Kingsbury Road, Minworth) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit (No.1))
Order 1984

The County Council of West Midlands in exercise of their powers under Section 74(1) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967, and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport given under Section 84B of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
2. The Borough of Sutton Coldfield (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit)(No.1) Order 1966 be hereby revoked in its entirety
3. This Order may be cited as "The West Midlands County Council (Kingsbury Road, Minworth)(40 m.p.h. Speed Limit (No.1)) Order 1984" and shall come into operation on the 10th day of September 1984.

SCHEDULE

That length of Kingsbury Road which extends from British Railway bridge No.16A to the roundabout at Sutton Coldfield By-Pass being a distance of approximately 612 metres

That length of Kingsbury Road which extends from the roundabout at Sutton Coldfield By-Pass to a point 220 metres west of its junction with Wiggins Hill Road being a distance of approximately 1355 metres
