Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. The length of road shown hatched on the plan marked "Birmingham City Council (Ox Leys Road Sutton Coldfield) (Speed Limit) Order 2010 shall become restricted road.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of Ox Leys Road shown cross hatched on the plan marked "Birmingham City Council (Ox Leys Road Sutton Coldfield) (Speed Limit) Order 2010
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August Two thousand and ten and may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (Ox Leys Road Sutton Coldfield) (Speed Limit) Order 2010
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the Interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
