

**BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL**  
**QUINTON EXPRESSWAY, QUINTON**  
**(SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2000**

Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") having given Public Notice in accordance with sub-section 2 of that section and having consulted the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Order shall come into force on the 8th December 2000, and may be cited as "Birmingham City Council Quinton Expressway, Quinton (Speed Limit) Order 2000".

**SCHEDULE**


**Quinton Expressway**

North bound on the into town side, the entire length of the road, from its junction with Manor Road to its junction with Hagley Road West.

South bound on the out of town side, from its junction with Hagley Road West to a distance of 150 metres beyond the tucan crossing.
