(SMALL HEATH HIGHWAY BIRMINGHAM)
(40 mph SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1986

The City of Birmingham District Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport given under Part II of Schedule 9 to the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The West Midlands County Council (40 mph Speed Limit) (No 1) Order 1981 is hereby revoked in its entirety.
3. This Order may be cited as "The ^{City of Birmingham District Council} ~~County Council of West Midlands~~ (Small Heath Highway Birmingham) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1986" and shall come into operation on the 23rd day of May 1986.

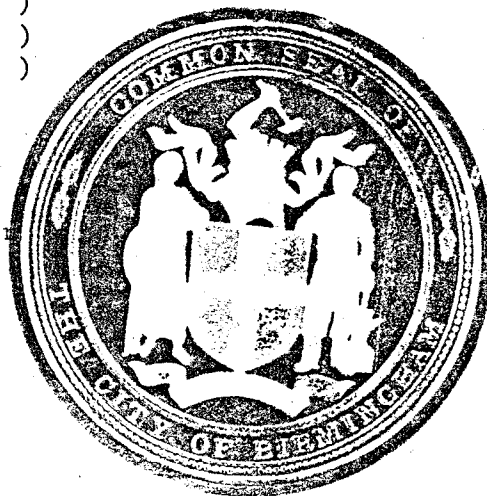
SCHEDULE

That length of road known as SMALL HEATH HIGHWAY in the City of Birmingham which extends from a point approximately 355 metres south east of its junction with Coventry Road Bordesley to its junction with Heybarnes Circus (but excluding the area of road forming the Poets Corner roundabout) a distance of approximately 2709 metres measured along the said length of road
