ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1962

The Borough Council of Sutton Coldfield
(40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No.1) Order 1963

The Council of the Borough of Sutton Coldfield in exercise of their powers under section 11(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1962, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Warwick and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order as follows:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on either of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Borough of Sutton Coldfield (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No.1) Order 1963" and shall come into operation on the twelfth day of June 1963.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of road in the Borough of Sutton Coldfield:-

B. 4148 Eachelhurst Road from the Borough boundary to a point approximately 100 yards south of the bridge over the Walsall/Water Orton railway, a distance of approximately 1,140 yards.

A. 453 College Road from the Borough boundary to a point immediately west of the College Road/Chester Road junction, a distance of approximately 250 yards.
