## BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL(THE BOROUGH OF SUTTON COLDFIELD) (40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT AND RESTRICTED ROADS) (No. 10) ORDER 1973 (VARIATION) ORDER 2005

Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order.

- This Order shall come into operation on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April Two Thousand and Five and may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (The Borough of Sutton Coldfield) (40 miles per hour Speed Limit and Restricted Roads) (No.10) Order 1973 (Variation) Order 2005"
- The reference to Slade Road (B 4151) contained in Schedule One to The Borough of Sutton Coldfield (40 miles per hour Speed Limit and Restricted Roads) (No. 10) Order 1973 (as amended) is hereby deleted.
- The length of Slade Road (B 4151) referred to in Article 2 of this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act of 1984.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the Interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
