BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT DIRECTION) (NO.1) ORDER 1962) (VARIATION) (No.2) ORDER 2016

Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 and 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th day of November Two Thousand and Sixteen and may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (The City of Birmingham (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit Direction) (No.1) Order 1962) (Variation) (No. 2) Order 2016".
- 2. The "The City of Birmingham (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit Direction) (No.1) Order 1962" (as amended) shall remain in full force and effect subject to the variations specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The length of Bristol Road and Bristol Road South referred to in the Order titled "The City of Birmingham (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit Direction) (No.1) Order 1962" (as amended) that is deleted from that Order by this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of Section 82 of the Act.
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the Interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULE (Article 2)

The references to BRISTOL ROAD AND BRISTOL ROAD SOUTH shall be deleted and the following inserted:

Bristol Road and Bristol Road South:-

southbound carriageway from the junction of Bristol Road with Weoley Park Road to a point approximately 65 yards south west of the kerb on the west side of Hole Lane.

Bristol Road and Bristol Road South:-

northbound carriageway from a point approximately 156 yards south west of the line of the kerb on the southwest side of Newhouse Farm Drive to the junction of Bristol Road with Weoley Park Road.
