BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (No. 4) ORDER 1976) (VARIATION) ORDER 2016

Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of August Two Thousand and Sixteen and may be cited as Birmingham City Council (The City of Birmingham District Council (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 4) Order 1976) (Variation) Order 2016".
- 2. The "The City of Birmingham District Council (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 4) Order 1976" as amended shall remain in full force and effect subject to the variations specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The lengths of Walsall Road referred to in the Order titled "The City of Birmingham District Council (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 4) Order 1976" that are deleted from that Order by this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of Section 82 of the Act.
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the Interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULE (Article 2)

In the Schedule to "The City of Birmingham District Council (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 4) Order 1976" the following references shall be deleted:

Walsall Road:-

From its junction with Aldridge Road to its junction with Queslett Road, a distance measured along the said road of approximately 4,175 yards.

The following references shall be inserted:

Walsall Road:-

From its junction with Aldridge Road to a point approximately 82 metres south east of the line of the kerb of Fairview Avenue.

From its junction with Queslett Road to a point 282 metres north west of the line of the kerb of Beeches Road.
