

**BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (THE TRUNK ROAD (ALDRIDGE AND SUTTON
COLDFIELD) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER, 1961) (VARIATION) ORDER
2022**

Birmingham City Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Section 82 and 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (“the Act”) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 16th day of September Two thousand and twenty two and may be cited as “Birmingham City Council (The Trunk Road (Aldridge and Sutton Coldfield) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order, 1961) (Variation) Order 2022”.
2. The “The Trunk Road (Aldridge and Sutton Coldfield) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order, 1961” (as amended) shall remain in full force and effect subject to the variations specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The length of London – Holyhead Trunk Road (A452) referred to in the Order titled “The Trunk Road (Aldridge and Sutton Coldfield) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order, 1961” (as amended) that is deleted from that Order by this Order shall become restricted road for the purposes of Section 82 of the Act.
4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 (“the Regulations”) when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of the Regulations.
5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the Interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULE (Article 2)

The reference to London – Holyhead Trunk Road (A452) shall be varied in so far as:

“That length of the London – Holyhead Road (A452) at Sutton Coldfield in the County of Warwick, and Aldridge in the County of Stafford, which extends from a point 557 yards north-west of its junction with King’s Road (B.4149)” shall be deleted and replaced with

“That length of Chester Road North (A452) which extends from a point approximately 157 metres north-west of the junction with Honiley Drive”.
