- 3. The reference to Hollyfield Road contained in the Schedule to The Borough of Sutton Coldfield (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 10) Order 1973 is hereby deleted.
- 4. The reference to Whitehouse Common Road contained in the Schedule to The Borough of Sutton Coldfield (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 10) Order 1973 is hereby deleted.
- 5. The reference to Penns Lane contained in the Schedule to The Borough of Sutton Coldfield (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 10) Order 1973 is hereby deleted.
- 6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 7. This Order may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (Walmley Road, etc, Sutton Coldfield) (Speed Limit) (Revocation) Order 2001" and shall come into operation on the 26th day of February Two Thousand and One.
