BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (WEST BOULEVARD ETC WOODGATE BIRMINGHAM) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1987

Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. This Order may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (West Boulevard etc Woodgate Birmingham) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1987" and shall come into operation on the 4th day of December 1987.

SCHEDULE

That length of road known as WEST BOULEVARD which extends from its roundabout junction with Court Oak Road to its roundabout junction with Tennal Lane a distance measured along the said length of approximately 350 metres.

That length of road known as WEST BOULEVARD which extends from its roundabout junction with Tennal Lane to its roundabout junction with Quinton Road West a distance measured along the said length of approximately 590 metres.

That length of road known as BARNES HILL which extends from a point 49 metres south of its junction with Stonehouse Lane to its roundabout junction with Stonehouse Lane a distance measured along the said length of approximately 40 metres.

That length of road known as WEST BOULEVARD EXTENSION which extends from its roundabout junction with Quinton Road West to its roundabout junction with Stonehouse Lane a distance measured along the said length of approximately 800 metres.
