NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make these Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 101 and 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be as follows:

1. Vary and introduce stopping restrictions along lengths of the A45 COVENTRY ROAD ETC RED ROUTE (SMALL HEATH HIGHWAY, COVENTRY ROAD, NEW COVENTRY ROAD and adjoining side roads).
2. Vary and introduce Bus Lanes on lengths of SMALL HEATH HIGHWAY, COVENTRY ROAD and NEW COVENTRY ROAD.

AMENDMENT TO PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council intends under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to amend the Pedestrian Crossings on COVENTRY ROAD in the vicinity of no.1807 and Lyndon Road.
