Safer School Journeys – Broadmeadow Junior School

Dear resident,

Safer School Journeys is a city-wide programme designed to make streets around schools safer, healthier and more welcoming for pupils, families and the wider community.

It helps schools tackle road safety concerns, improve local air quality, and encourage more children and families to walk, wheel and cycle.

Broadmeadow Junior School has been selected for improvements as part of this programme.

We are proposing to introduce:

- No waiting (at any time) restrictions along sections of Moneyhull Hall Road and Broadmeadow Lane with targeted 'No Loading' restrictions at school peak times
- No waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) at top of Walkers Heath Road
- A relocated eastbound bus stop away from the school entrance on Bells Lane and removal of layby area
- Bollards or planters to stop parking on pavements and access points
- Clearer signs and coloured road surfacing, including on approach to crossings, to make drivers aware they are entering an area with a school
- Planting, seating and cycle parking to improve the look and feel of the area

These improvements will help reduce road danger, improve air quality, and create a safer, healthier, more pleasant environment for everyone.
