

Safer School Journeys – St Benedict’s Primary School

Dear resident,

Safer School Journeys is a city-wide programme to make streets around schools safer, healthier and more welcoming.

St Benedict’s School has been selected for improvements as part of this programme.

We are proposing to introduce:

- A one-way on Heather Road (from Somerville Road to Coventry Road) to improve access and safety
- A one-way on St Benedicts Road (from Coventry Road to Somerville Road) to improve access and safety
- Junction narrowing where both roads meet Coventry Road to slow vehicles and make it easier and safer for people to cross the road
- Refurbishment of existing crossing points outside school to make it easier and safer for people to cross the road
- Widened pavement and extended markings outside the school on St Benedicts Road to improve visibility and provide more space for people walking and wheeling
- Coloured road surfacing and repainting of worn-out road markings to make drivers aware they are entering an area with a school

These improvements will help reduce road danger, improve air quality, and create a safer, healthier, more pleasant environment for everyone.
