NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make these Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 101 and 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended) and the Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) Order 2005 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be as follows:

1. To vary/introduce waiting/loading restrictions on WASHWOOD HEATH ROAD, ASTON CHURCH ROAD, BENNETTS ROAD, COMMON LANE, CORONATION ROAD, HIGHFIELD ROAD, LEIGH ROAD, MALTHOUSE LANE, MEMBURY ROAD, SANDWAY GARDENS, WARD END PARK ROAD & WRIGHT ROAD, BIRMINGHAM.
- 2 To introduce lengths of Bus Lane on sections of WASHWOOD HEATH ROAD, BIRMINGHAM, (between the junctions of Membury Road and Drews Lane) operational Mon – Fri, 7 – 10am and 1 – 7pm.
