#### **Public Consultation**

Selly Oak has the opportunity to be at the forefront of Birmingham's transformation into a modern, vibrant international city. Our role is to encourage and guide development that will help make Birmingham one of the world's top cities – a place where people increasingly want to live, work and visit and where businesses choose to invest.

Selly Oak / South Edgbaston is experiencing major investment in strategic healthcare and educational facilities, bringing about transformational change to this unique area of Birmingham.

Capitalising upon its national and international assets, and with further exciting opportunities available, Selly Oak / South Edgbaston is set to become one of Europe's largest regeneration areas.

Since the adoption of the Selly Oak Local Action Plan in 2001, much has been achieved, whilst new opportunities have come forward prompting a review and update; this Draft SPD is the result of that review.

Building upon the guidance provided by the Local Action Plan, this SPD is intended to primarily set out a strategy for realising the economic potential of the area. It:

- Sets out a vision for the transformation of Selly Oak / South Edgbaston.
- Identifies the key development opportunities / sites.
- Sets out policies to guide development and ensure that regeneration proposals coming forward, contribute to the overall vision.
- Encourages investment in Selly Oak / South Edgbaston, to secure the coordinated and comprehensive regeneration of the area.
- Provides a framework to support bids for funding

Public consultation on the draft SPD will run from **7 July to 17 August 2014**. This will provide you with an opportunity to comment on the proposed policies and development opportunities.


