

## BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (BELCHERS LANE ETC., HODGE HILL ETC.) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201\*

NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make an Order under Sections 84 (1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended); the effect of which will be:

To introduce 20 miles per hour speed limit, in the Bordesley Green, Small Heath and Washwood Heath areas, including the entire lengths or sections of BAKER STREET, BELCHERS LANE, BERTRAM ROAD, DREWS LANE, EVERSLEY ROAD, GRANGE ROAD, GREEN LANE, HAWKES STREET and NEWLAND ROAD.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with the plans and a statement of the Council's reasons for the proposals, may be examined by appointment during normal working hours at the Hodge Hill District Office, The Shard, All Saints Square, Shard End Crescent, B34 7AG or Ladywood District Office, Summerfield Community Centre, Winson Green Road, B18 4EJ or Yardley District Office, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Fox Hollies Leisure Centre, Shirley Road, Acocks Green, B27 7NS or Highways, 1 Lancaster Circus Queensway, Birmingham, B4 7DQ.
