NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make an Order under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended); the effect of which will be as follows:

To introduce a 20 miles per hour speed limit, in the Kings Heath and Moor Green area, including the entire lengths or sections of **VICARAGE ROAD, ALCESTER ROAD SOUTH, AVENUE ROAD, BROOK LANE** and **DAD'S LANE**.
