

## BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (VICARAGE ROAD ETC, MOSELEY & KINGS HEATH, ETC) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201\*

NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make an Order under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended); the effect of which will be as follows:

To introduce a 20 miles per hour speed limit, in the Kings Heath and Moor Green area, including the entire lengths or sections of VICARAGE ROAD, ALCESTER ROAD SOUTH, AVENUE ROAD, BROOK LANE and DAD'S LANE.
