## Highway improvement scheme, Aston Hall Road, Aston

I'm writing to inform you about a proposed highway improvement scheme at the junction of Aston Hall Road/ Priory Road, which will be delivered to support the redevelopment of a key industrial plot at the Aston Advanced Manufacturing Hub (AMH).

The proposed scheme comprises:

• a four- arm roundabout at the junction of Aston Hall Road/ Priory Road, together with the conversion of Priory Road into a two way operation (currently one way).

A plan is attached for your information. The roundabout scheme will specifically serve plot 2 at the AMH (highlighted on the plan), alongside new and existing industrial development. A provisional timetable for the scheme has been identified, which will start in winter 2017 with completion in mid-2018. The developer, who will be responsible for delivering the works, will be in touch before the scheme starts on site to confirm timescales and inform you about the necessary diversions or temporary traffic lights that will be put in place to minimise travel disruption.

The AMH, which is being brought forward by the City Council in partnership with the Homes and Communities Agency (HCA), is one of six economic zones in Birmingham. It captures the importance of the advanced manufacturing sector to the wider West Midlands, and is an ideal location for industrial development given its location within proximity to the M6. The scheme will improve accessibility across the AMH, benefiting the local area.
