NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make these Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended) the effect of which will be as follows:

1. To introduce a No U-Turn on **ISLINGTON ROW** (both directions) at the newly created gap in the central reservation at Bath Row
2. To extend the existing Red Route Restrictions on **BATH ROW** at its junction with Islington Row
