## (A4540 RING ROAD ETC BIRMINGHAM) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (RED ROUTE) ORDER 2014 (VARIATION) ORDER 201\*

NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make these Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 101 and 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended) and the Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) Order 2005 the effect of which will be as follows:

- 1. To introduce a One-way traffic flow along a length of **GEORGE ROAD** south of Islington Row
- 2. To introduce a Reserved Bus Lane and Bus Only gate on **GEORGE ROAD** south of Islington Row
- 3. To extend the Red Route restrictions along a length of **GEORGE ROAD** south of Islington Row
