Battery Way Extension - Tyseley

The City Council is proposing a new link road to extend the existing Battery Way between Reddings Lane and Warwick Road through former industrial land.

The new link road is proposed to be a single lane carriageway with new footway, cycle lane provisions and landscaped areas providing access to the new development site together with improving traffic flow and helping to reduce congestion on Weston Lane and the local highway network. It is anticipated the new development site will potentially provide 345,000sq ft. of industrial development land and up to 1100 jobs overall. The new link road is subject to securing planning consent and full business case approvals.

The Council would like to hear your views on these proposals and would be grateful if you could attend one of the public consultation exhibitions. The details of the consultation road shows are as follows:

Saturday 14th February 2015 between 1000hrs - 1400hrs
