The A38 Bristol Road Corridor Cycle Scheme is located in the Edgbaston, Ladywood, Selly Oak and Nechells wards of Birmingham. It is part of the Birmingham Cycle Revolution Programme. The programme aims to make cycling more accessible for transport and leisure. The vision is for 10% of all journeys in Birmingham to be made by bike by 2033. The scheme will provide a segregated cycletrack of approximately 4km in length between

Selly Oak and the city centre. The alignment of the route is along Bristol Road, Bristol Street, Wrentham Street and Kent Street. The scheme will also provide changes to existing traffic signal junctions and new signal controlled crossing facilities along the route.

The formal reasons for proposing the new Order are:

- a) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
- b) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
