





These works are part of the **Birmingham Cycle Revolution** which aims to make cycling an everyday way to travel in Birmingham over the next 20 years.

We want 5% of all trips in the city to be made by bike by 2023 and to double this again to 10% by 2033. This will help to make our city healthier, greener, safer and less congested as part of our **Birmingham Connected** Transport Strategy.

Birmingham Cycle Revolution includes:

More cycle facilities on main roads with cycle lanes and junction improvements

Provide signed cycle routes on quieter roads

20 20mph speed limits in residential areas

Resurfacing and upgrading canal towpaths

New and improved cycling routes through parks and open spaces

Improve local links to join up on and off road cycle routes

New secure cycle parking

FREE bikes, loan and hire schemes, training and activities through the Big Birmingham Bikes project
