### **Birmingham Cycle Revolution: Local Links Package 3 – Heartlands Parkway**

Birmingham Cycle Revolution is an exciting initiative to encourage more people to cycle in and around the city. Our vision is to make cycling an everyday way to travel in Birmingham. We want 5% of all trips in the city to be made by bike by 2023 and to double this again to 10% by 2033. This will help to make our city healthier, greener, safer and less congested.

Heartlands Parkway is included in the Local Link schemes which represent on-highway works to facilitate cycle movement to and from the off-road Green Routes (particularly where these cross public roads) and to link them to the main on-street cycling network.

The proposals for Heartlands Parkway include the provision of a shared use cycleway/footway to allow access to the existing toucan crossing and main cycle route.

The details of the proposals are shown on the attached plan CA-02526\_S01\_06\_04\_06\_008.
