Bristol Road Selly Oak Enhancement Scheme Consultation

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Bristol Road Selly Oak Enhancement scheme that is proposed for construction in spring 2023, subject to gaining the necessary approvals.

The final phase of the Selly Oak New Road (SONR) scheme which consisted of highway improvements for all road users to the 'Selly Oak Triangle', was completed in January 2021. Now that the SONR project has been completed, the planned improvements through Selly Oak Local Centre can be brought forward to bring about enhancement opportunities. The strategic aims of the Bristol Road Selly Oak Enhancement scheme are to improve the attraction for sustainable transport, better management of traffic and parking together with public transport and environmental improvements. The scheme proposals include;

- Carriageway reduced through the local centre from four lanes to two lanes;
- Implementing a bi-directional cycle lane to create a cycle link between the existing A38 segregated cycle facility from the city centre to the recently upgraded 'Selly Oak Triangle';
- Pedestrian and cycling crossing improvement measures at Selly Oak Station, Dale Road / Bristol Road and North Road / Bristol Road junctions.
- Installation of cycle parking stands throughout the local centre; and
- Kerb build-outs to define on-street parking areas in the local centre
