CROSS CITY BUS PHASE 1 PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS

The purpose of this letter is to make residents and businesses more aware of proposals to introduce Traffic Regulation Orders in their locality. NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make these Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53,101 and 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended) and the Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) Order 2005 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be as follows:

- 1. To introduce a No Waiting at any time and No Loading at any time restriction on lengths of MARGARET STREET, CORNWALL STREET, EDMUND STREET and SNOW HILL QUEENSWAY;
- 2. To introduce a No Waiting at any time and No Loading, 8am to 7.30pm restriction on lengths of EDMUND STREET;
- 3. To introduce a Loading Only, 20 Mins No Return 1 Hour restrictions on lengths of CORNWALL STREET and EDMUND STREET;
- 4. To remove Loading Only restriction on a length of MARGARET STREET;
- 5. To remove Parking Place with Payment restrictions on lengths of MARGARET STREET and EDMUND STREET and CORNWALL STREET;
- 6. To remove a Motor Cycle Only Parking Place restriction on a length of MARGARET STREET;
- 7. To introduce a Motor Cycle Only Parking Place restriction on a length of CORNWALL STREET;
- 8. To introduce a Car Club Only Parking Place restriction on a length of CORNWALL STREET;
- 9. To remove a Car Club Parking Place restriction on a length of MARGARET STREET;
- 10. To introduce an Electric Vehicles Only Parking Place 3 hours No Return 4 hours restriction on a length of CORNWALL STREET;
- 11. To remove an Electric Vehicles Only Parking Place 3 hours No Return 3 hours restriction on a length of MARGARET STREET:
- 12. To introduce Disabled Badge Holders Only Parking Place restrictions on lengths of CORNWALL STREET:
- 13. To remove Disabled Badge Holders Only Parking Place restrictions on lengths of MARGARET STREET and EDMUND STREET;
- 14. To amend lengths of Bus Lanes, all day every day, except Taxis, Motor Cycles and Pedal Cycles restrictions on GREAT CHARLES STREET QUEENSWAY and MARGARET STREET;
- 15. To introduce a Bus Lane, all day every day, except Taxis and Pedal Cycles restriction on SNOW HILL QUEENSWAY:
- 16. To introduce a No Right Turn except Buses, Taxis and Pedal Cycles restriction on GREAT CHARLES STREET QUEENSWAY into NEWHALL STREET.
