NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make these Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53,101 and 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended) the effect of which will be as follows:

- 1. To vary waiting & loading restrictions on DUDLEY ROAD, HEATH STREET SOUTH, HOOPER STREET, SPRING HILL, WESTERN ROAD, BIRMINGHAM
- 2 To introduce No Right Turns;
  - a. on HOOPER STREET at the junction with Dudley Road.
  - b. on DUDLEY ROAD at its junction with Hooper Street.
  - c. on the access/egress road to Birmingham City Hospital at the junction with Dudley Road.
- 3 To introduce No U Turns on DUDLEY ROAD;
  - a. at a point approximately 75 metres west of Hooper Street.
  - b. both sides of its junction with Western Road.
  - c. at the eastern end of the central reservation east of the junction with Western Road.
