(TEMPORARY SPEED LIMITS) (T20211455)

ORDER 2020

Notice is hereby given that Birmingham City Council intend, not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make an Order the effect of which will be to:

Introduce a 20mph Speed Limit on A38 Bristol Road from Dawlish Road to The Dingle

Introduce a 30 mph Speed Limit on A38 Bristol Road from The Dingle to a point approximately 80 metres southwest of its junction with Hole Lane.

The temporary Order is required for safety reasons connected to the introduction of cycle lanes and tracks on the road.

These prohibitions shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

The Order will come into operation on 28th August 2020 and will remain in force for a period of 18 months or until the cycle lanes or tracks are removed whichever is the earlier.
