

**BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL
(A47 JENNENS ROAD & NECHELLS PARKWAY)
(MOVEMENT) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2020**

Birmingham City Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 9, 10(1) and 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 10th of December Two Thousand and Twenty and will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months. The Order may be cited as the “Birmingham City Council (A47 Jennens Road & Nechells Parkway) (Movement) (Experimental) Order 2020”.
2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - “Carriageway(s) and Footway(s)” have the same meaning as in Section 329(1) of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended);
 - “Central Reservation” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
 - “Highway” means all Carriageways, Footways, Central Reservations and verges;
 - “Mechanical Road Cleansing Vehicle” means a vehicle used for the purpose of cleaning the Highway;
 - “Pedal Cycle” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
 - “Road” means any length of Highway or any other road to which the public has access and includes bridges over which a road passes as set out in Section 142(1) of the Act.
3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
4. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
5. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
6. Where in any Article in this Order reference is made to columns 2, 3 or 4 as appropriate of a Schedule, these references relate to the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule.
7. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

8. In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Act, the Assistant Director of Transport and Connectivity or a person authorised by the Assistant Director of Transport and Connectivity, if it appears to that person essential (a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or (b) in the interests of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the Highway, or (c) for the preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any Road affected by this Order runs, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police, may modify or suspend any provision of this Order, save that no modification shall make an addition.

No Left Turn

9. Save as provided in Article 10, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the Road or length of Road specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 on reaching the point specified in column 2 to make a left turn into the Road or length of Road specified in column 3 subject to any exemptions, if any, specified in column 4 of that Schedule.
10. Nothing in Articles 9 shall apply to:
 - (a) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
 - (b) The driving of any Mechanical Road Cleansing Vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
